## COURSE OBJECTIVE

The course will provide information about legal protection of journalists in their interaction with law enforcement, detail how law-enforcement can use materials published by investigative journalists, and they can protect sources and witnesses. The course will also touch upon the subject of digital evidence in war crimes prosecution.

- Understanding and consciously using accurate law enforcement language in reporting on law enforcement operations.
  - Evaluating law enforcement inaction on allegations of corruption and money laundering.
  - Recognizing the challenges law enforcement faces when using leaked data or privileged information.
  - Understanding the legal protections provided to journalists and their sources.
- Assessing interactions with law enforcement and international institutions that investigate and prosecute war crimes before approaching these institutions.
  - Identifying international mechanisms for utilizing law enforcement reporting to facilitate change in law enforcement anti-corruption and anti-money laundering mechanisms.
